Distinguished Alumni & Young Alumni Award

Nomination Guidelines

Eligibility Requirements: Nominees must be graduates of the School of Law. All nominations are under consideration for three consecutive years. All nominees must have at least one letter/email recommendation.

Selection Criteria: Award recipients are selected on the basis of several factors, the most important being career achievement. Because alumni are found in such a wide variety of careers, consideration is not restricted to graduates who have followed a traditional legal career path. In addition to career achievement, consideration is given to contributions to education, civic causes, professional societies and public service.

Those being honored share the same characteristics of leadership, progressive thinking, high standards, uncompromising integrity, commitment, courage, and confidence. Their careers serve as models for all Washington University students and alumni.

The **Distinguished Young Law Alumni Awards** honor alumni who graduated from the School of Law within the past 25 years. The recipients exemplify achievement and commitment to the ideals embodied in a School of Law education.

Letter of Recommendation to include: Nominee name and address, career history, special career achievement (please be specific), public service, volunteer activities, brief statement outlining why you feel the nominee should receive the award.
